

5TH GRADE SUPPLY LIST - 2008-2009 School Year

Please have all supplies on the first day of school.

- Assignment notebook – purchased through St. Nicholas book store
- Erasable pens (2) packs of four (blue or black only)
- Pencils (sharpened)
- Scissors
- 2 glue sticks (no liquid glue)
- Colored pencils (sharpened)
- Markers (washable, classic colors, wide tip, pack of 8)
- 2 red ink pens (ballpoint, no clicking or gel)
- 4 folders (2 pocket)
- 1 pen/pencil pouch (vinyl bag, **not box**)
- 12 subject graphic organizer or expandable file – available at Target, K-Mart and office supply stores (no larger than 12 pocket))
- 1 stick of deodorant (no spray cans)
- 1 pack of filler paper
- 1 box of Kleenexes
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 bag of hard candy such as peppermints or jolly ranchers (to be given as treats for the class)
- 1 container of tennis balls (quantity of at least 4) --- please precut the tennis balls by making a 2 inch X in the center of each ball
- 2 dry erase markers
- 1 ruler (needs inches and centimeters)
- 1 Bible (purchased through St. Nicholas)
- 7 stretch book covers (large)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (last name begins with A-L)
- 1 container of disinfectant handy wipes (last name begins with M-Z)

- 1 package graph paper (should say ¼” grid paper or 4 squares per inch) (last name begins with A-L)
